Car safety will be stressed and all the children will earn a special "Safety Award" and will be bringing home a notice for you to sign that they ALWAYS wear their seatbelt, sitting quietly in the car too. We are looking forward to a fun day for our "Safety Party". Come in and view our "Safety Chart" and see how many children received their heart stickers.



The children will continue to create and learn in a fun, age appropriate way. The skill of scissor safety will be introduced and each child will receive one on one attention when learning this fine motor skill. Each child will have the opportunity to strengthen their fine motor skills at their own pace. Each child will be encouraged to begin this lesson, but not forced. This is a very difficult task and we want all the children to have fun with it. Some children may not be ready for this motor skill and we will be observant of each child's ability. You may want to buy a pair of safety scissors for home so that your child can practice. Cutting up pieces of paper or pictures from magazines or newspapers is a fun way to help with this skill. What a fun way to develop little hands!

Learning to recognize letters through games and identifying our friend's names is so much fun. What a smart group of early learners we have here.
