The children are developing good listening and learning skills through Circle Time, Story Time and activities. What a fabulous group of little ones we have here!



Eating healthy and staying healthy will be important discussions this month. We encourage sharing but we never want to share our GERMS! The children have been learning to take care of themselves and others by always covering their mouths when they cough or sneeze. Using our ELBOWS has been a great way to start and it's fun too! We will emphasize that it is important to always use a tissue and throw it away (never use your sleeve and never pick your nose!! YUCK!).

Learning to make healthy choices about food is so important. Going to bed when Mommy and Daddy tell us to is also very important, so that we grow big and strong and stay healthy.



Washing hands before we eat and after we use the bathroom will help keep all of us healthy too. You will be surprised at how independent your little one is becoming.



Fine motor skills are developing and the use of safety scissors has become part of our creative activities. We have many different kinds of safety scissors for little hands and we will be working with your child as he/she enjoys this lesson. Each child will learn and develop at his or her own pace. Some little hands are not ready yet to manipulate scissors and we will be working with each child as they develop this skill. The most important thing is that each child feels happy and confident in his/her accomplishments.

The class parent will be reaching out to you for help with your child's Valentine celebration. We will be celebrating Valentine's Day on Tuesday, February 13. Valentine's Day cards are a fun way for the children to show their friends that they are important and loved. The children will be making a very special Valentine carrier to bring their cards home!
